INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTERING CONFORMATION OBEDIENCE AND RALLY

USE ONLY OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS (photocopies of entry blanks without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of form will not be accepted).

ANY ENTRY BLANKS WITHOUT COMPLETE INFORMATION, NOT SIGNED OR ACCOMPANIED BY FEES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

ENTRY FEES will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

NO ENTRY shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

NO DOGS wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying To Dog Shows.

MOVE UPS Must be made 30 Minutes before start of Judging.

OWNERS AND HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, and entering the same dog twice, regardless of who may make such errors or duplicate entries.

NEW CHAMPIONS Any dog that finishes its championship according to the owners records may be transferred up to 30 minutes before the start of judging.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

TROPHIES MUST BE PICKED UP THE DAY OF THE SHOW. NO TROPHIES WILL BE MAILED OR OTHERWISE DISTRIBUTED.

RULES

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

## AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sections of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented:

Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.

- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The Sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies the sport of purebred dogs
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club.

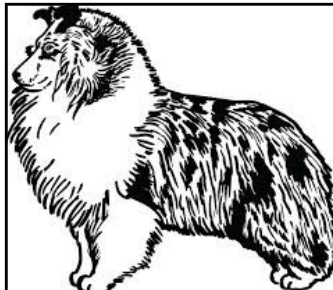

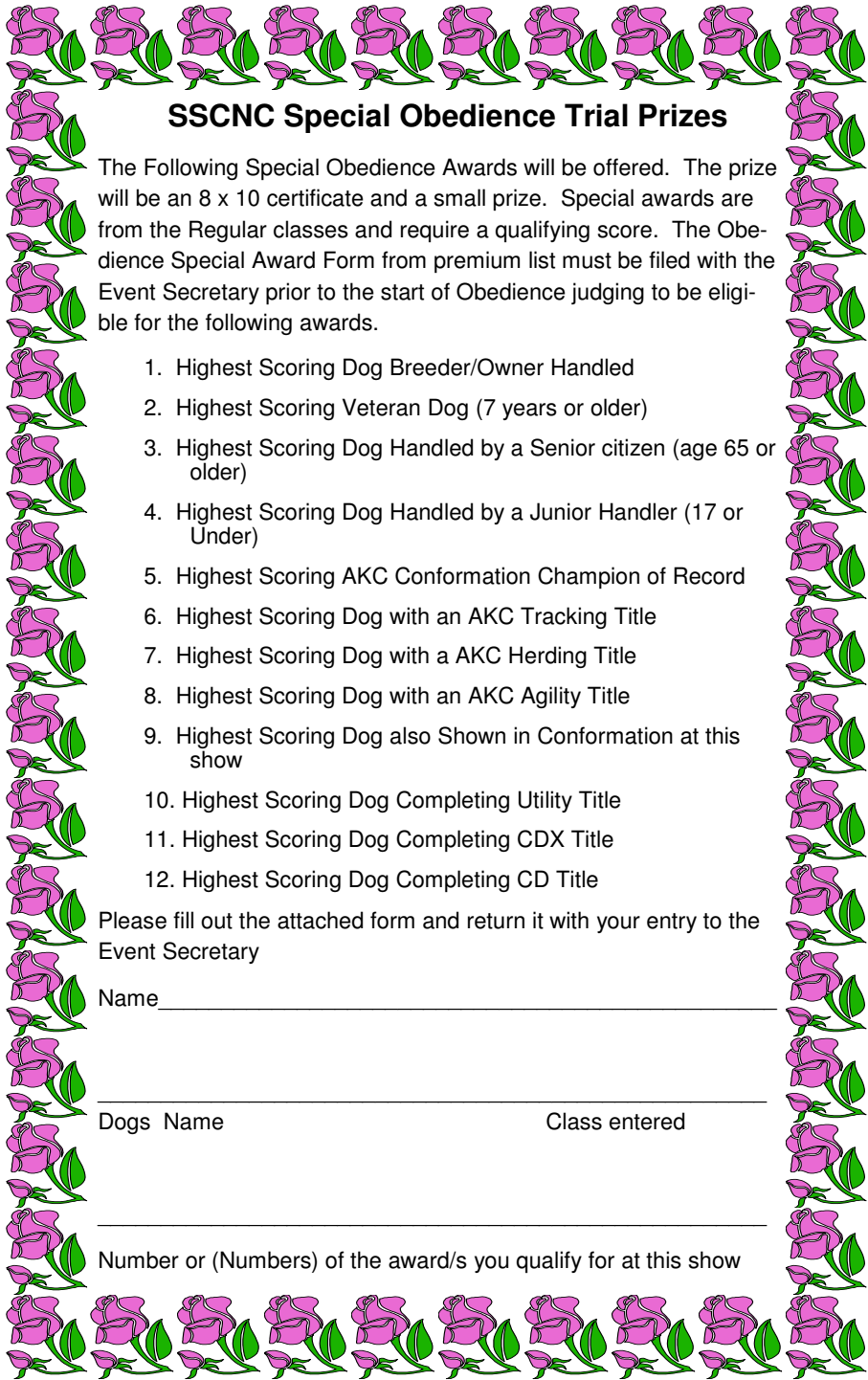
