Transfers / Move-Ups – Move-ups to Best of Breed and other permitted class corrections, must be requested in writing to the Show Secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of regular conformation judging for that event.

Refund for Bitches in Season for Obedience/Rally – Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally classes. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the entry fee for Obedience and/or Rally will be refunded. The exhibitor must provide a veterinarian’s certificate within one week of the Trial to obtain the refund. A processing fee of \$10.00 per day will be retained.

COVID-19 Safety Procedures

Club officials, judges, stewards, all participants and persons attending these events are required to follow the current COVID-19 safety guidelines issued by the State of California, San Joaquin County, the City of Lodi, All Dogs Sports Park LLC, and Sycamore Lane Kennels and Farm.

All Dogs Sports Park LLC and Sycamore Lane Kennels and Farm require that all persons attending must provide a signed COVID-19 Waiver upon entering the grounds. An additional SSCNC Liability Release Waiver will be required to be filed. Both forms are available at the back of the judging program.

Upon entering the grounds and parking, all attendees should bring their signed waivers to the central check-in desk in the show area. You will receive a wristband and access to the rings. Persons without wristbands will not be allowed into the show area, nor allowed to pick up armbands, nor to exhibit a dog in the ring.

Judges may make additional rules for inside their rings, such as requiring face masks in the ring. A sign will be posted at the ring. Please be prepared with a face mask.

Sycamore Lane Kennels - Parking Restrictions

Sycamore Lane Kennels & Farm and All Dogs Sports Park provides parking for your event participants and spectators (\$5/vehicle). We ask you to abide by a few simple rules:

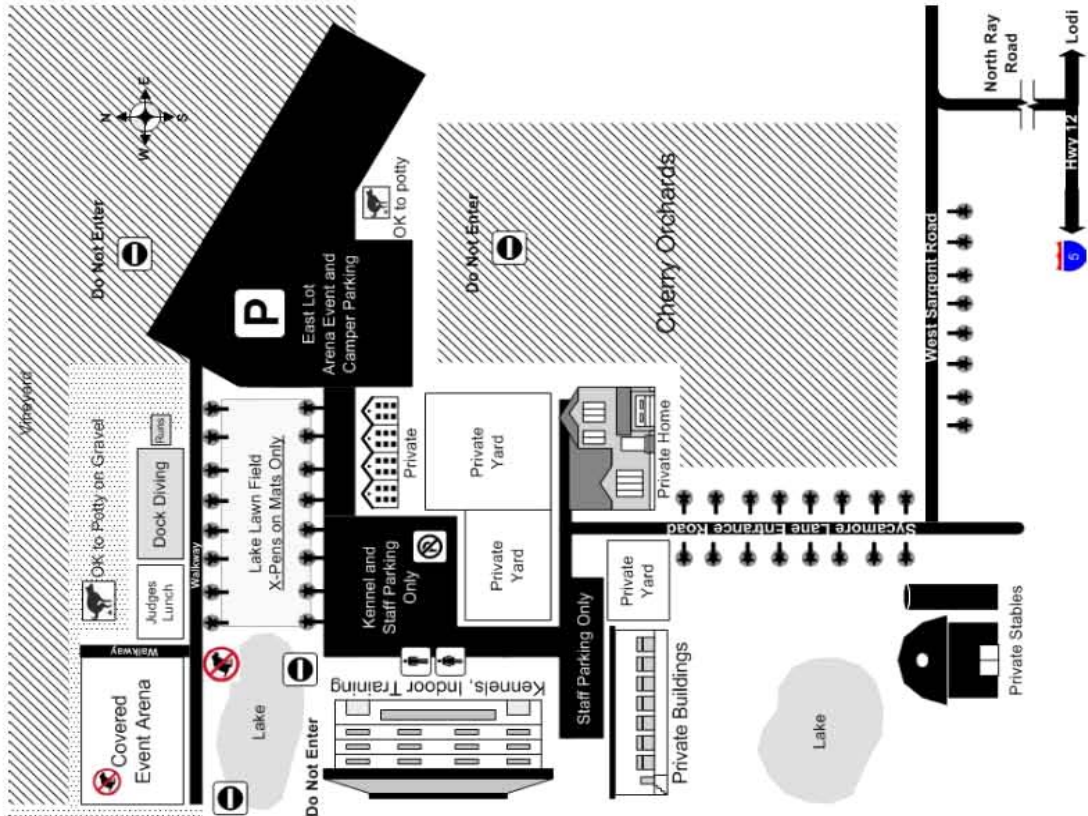
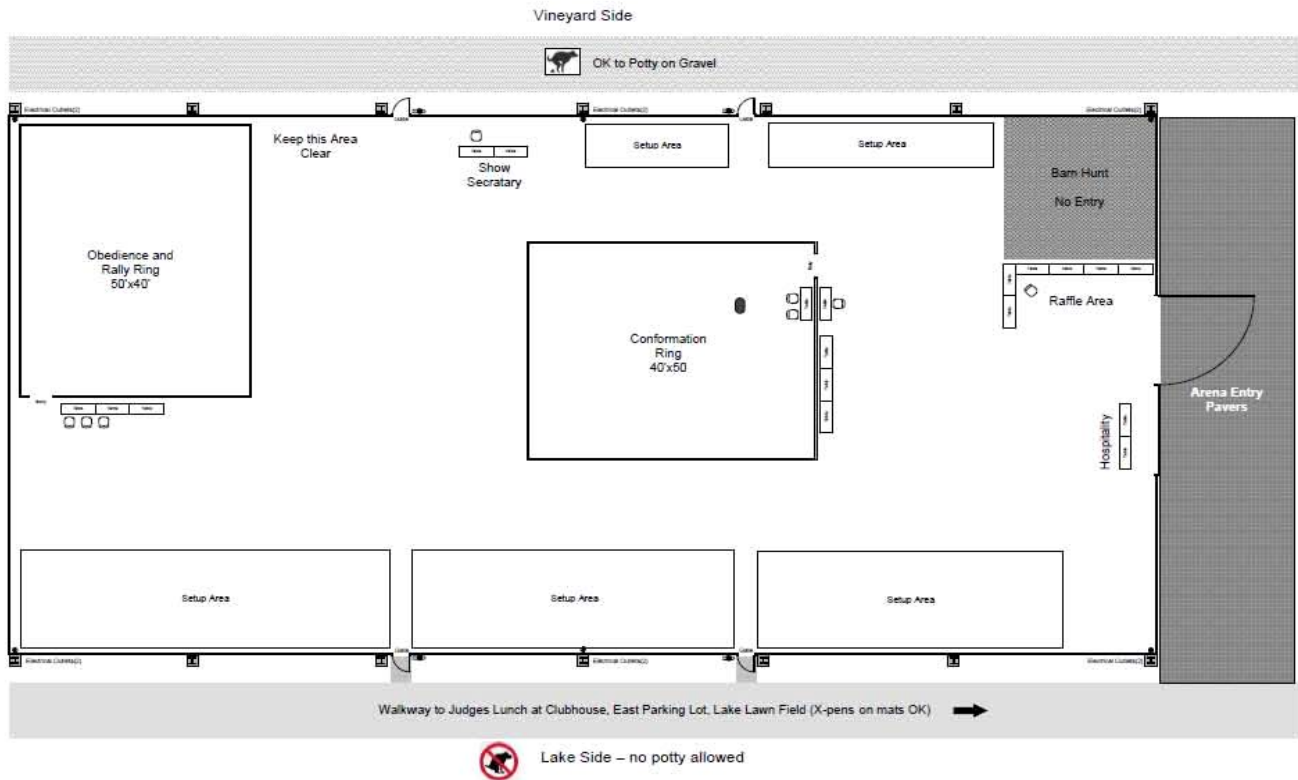
1. Do not park near or around the kennel or groom shop.
2. Parking is not allowed around the pond or between the lawn and the pool. These are designated fire lanes. Vehicles will be towed at owner's expense and could be subject to a fine.
3. Parking is NOT allowed in the lot adjacent to the lawn, bordered by the training building, the exercise yard and the duplex. Parking is to the east of the pond lawn.
4. The dirt area between the pool and the vineyard is reserved for the event coordinators and volunteers.

Sycamore Lane Kennels - Grounds Information

1. The yards marked "kennel personnel only" means just that. Please do not use these yards.
2. Please do not let your dogs potty on the lawn by the pond, in the planters around the pond, in or close to the vineyard. The dirt area is fine and the potty runs behind the pool are also for your use.
3. Use the potty yards behind the pool, the dirt (but not in the grapes) or the circle of grass to the east of the pool in the rv parking lot.
4. We provide pooper scoopers and disposal buckets. Please pick up after your dog.
5. All dogs must stay a minimum of 5 feet apart, unless from the same family.
6. No retractable leashes (i.e. NO FLEXI LEADS).
7. X-pens and crates must have bottoms if you are placing them on the lawn or in the arena (no x-pen set up in the arena). If you leave them on the lawn overnight, please tip them on end.
8. Please do not take your dogs into the human bathrooms.
9. The lane is for exercising kennel dogs, some of whom are not friendly. Please stay away from this area.
10. The pool is off-limits, unless the pool is part of your lease.

Clean Up Is Your Responsibility!!! If your dog soils the grounds it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form for these dog shows you are agreeing that clean up is your responsibility.

Special Attention - Safety of Dogs: No owner or agent shall allow his/her animals to be put in jeopardy of the elements. To do so may result in damaged vehicles during rescue attempts by the event committee.





COVID-19 WAIVER
