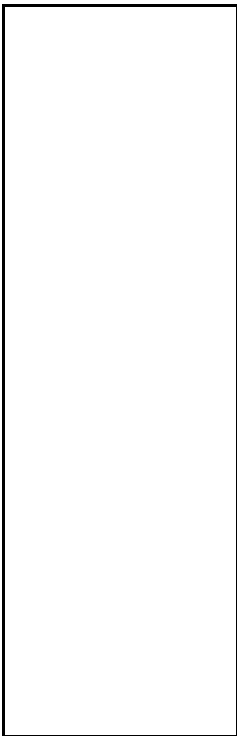

Additional Rules - Grounds, Clean-Up, and Safety

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club Rules shall be allowed within the show limits. Puppies under 6 months old are not allowed to be within the show limits.

THERE WILL BE NO exercise pens, crates, tents or grooming tables allowed in the aisles adjacent to the judging rings. All grooming must be done in areas specified by the Club.

EXHIBITORS must obey and abide by all regulations of the management of the facility owning the show site. These events will be held on private property. Please be respectful of the owners and their home and business.

- Do not block the entrances to the business center of Sycamore Lane Kennel.
- Clean up after your dog(s). Dispose of dog waste in buckets labelled specifically for that purpose. Do not use the garbage bins for dog waste.
- Dispose of other garbage in containers placed on the show grounds.
- Canopies and ex-pens will be allowed in specified areas. Mats need to be placed under any ex-pens. For set-ups on the lawn area, mats beneath ex-pens need to be picked up and draped over ex-pens at night to prevent damage to the lawn.
- Do not allow your dog(s) to dig at the lawn area.
- Absolutely no dogs or people are permitted in the dock diving area.
- **FRIDAY SET-UP.** Exhibitors will **NOT** be allowed onto the grounds until approximately 4:30 PM on Friday afternoon for setup. Exact time will be published in the judging program.

Notice To Exhibitors

ENTRIES: Conditional, unsigned, incomplete entries will not be accepted. Telegraph or telephone entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side are NOT acceptable. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms, and for entering the same dog twice, regardless who may make such errors or duplicate entries. No entry may be changed or canceled, unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hours for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging, and except that dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6.)

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

POST DATED CHECKS or returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis

THE CLUB MAY DECLINE ENTRIES for any cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY AND SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME will be sent to the address on the Official AKC Entry Form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, the Show Secretary should be contacted. Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Confirmations will be electronic and/or mailed.

DOGS NEED TO BE at the show only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is scheduled to be judged.

THE SHOW GIVING CLUB, its officers and directors, the Show Secretary, their agents or employees, assume no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, or by any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring. It is to be distinctly understood by all exhibitors that their dogs are to be in their custody and care at all times and that the dog's welfare is their sole responsibility.

ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS SHOW hereby waive any claim for damages against the Shetland Sheepdog Club of Northern California, Inc. its members, and Show Secretary in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation

COVID-19 Safety Procedures

Club officials, judges, stewards, all participants and persons attending these events are required to follow the current COVID-19 safety guidelines issued by the State of California, San Joaquin County, the City of Lodi, All Dogs Sports Park LLC, and Sycamore Lane Kennels and Farm.

All Dogs Sports Park LLC and Sycamore Lane Kennels and Farm require that all persons attending must provide a signed COVID-19 Waiver upon entering the grounds. (See waiver on Page 18.) This may be sent with your entry form or provided at the show.

Please continue to be cognizant of the health and safety of all persons with social distancing and not congregating with those outside your immediate household. The SSCNC may require additional protocols which may include face masks, additional waiver forms, or other measures.

* Bred By Exhibitor (BBE) Class eligibility (revised 09/02). All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Dogs (7 years & over)	Veteran Bitches (7 years & over)
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Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at Independent Specialty Shows.

Best of Breed Competition

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record; and Dogs that are Champions of Record which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by The American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC.

Award of Merit: At his/her discretion, the judge may present one Award of Merit rosette for every seven entries in Best of Breed competition excluding Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Winners Dog & Winners Bitch, that by virtue of their placement, have already been recognized.

Special Attention

No owner or agent shall allow his/her animals to be put in jeopardy of the elements. To do so may result in damaged vehicles during rescue attempts by the event committee.

Breed Prizes

The SSCNC wishes to thank its members and friends who make our show prizes possible through their donations. Prizes and donors will be listed in the catalog, and except as noted will be offered by the Shetland Sheepdog Club of Northern California, Inc. and our members.

CLASSES: Puppy Sweepstakes shall be divided into six age classes (as named below) three for each sex and judged down to fourth place. Veteran Sweepstakes shall be divided into four age classes (as named below) two for each sex and judged down to fourth place.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Entry fee \$10.00 which is added to the regular entry fee. Entry is made by marking in Additional Class on the regular entry form "Sweepstakes" and the age class. All entries in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class.

Puppy Sweepstakes Classification

Puppy Dogs, 6 months & under 9 months	Puppy Bitches, 6 months & under 9 months
Puppy Dogs, 9 months & under 12 months	Puppy Bitches, 9 months & under 12 months
Dogs, 12 months & under 18 months	Bitches, 12 months & under 18 months

BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES: Shall be chosen from the first place winner of each of six above classes.
RUNNER-UP TO BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES: Shall be chosen from remaining finalists and second place from the class of the BIS Winner.

ELIGIBILITY: The Sweepstakes shall be open to any Shetland Sheepdog eligible for competition in the regular AKC classes whose age will be no less than six months and under eighteen months on the day of the judging. The exception to this rule is as follows: No Dog which has completed the requirements for a championship prior to the date of judging shall compete in the judging of the sweepstakes.

INELIGIBLE DOGS: Should it be that an ineligible dog has received an award in the Sweepstakes, the person to whom such award was presented shall make restitution to the Club and such award shall be deemed to have been won by the dog judged second to the dog declared ineligible. The prize money and other awards shall then be redistributed to conform to the rules.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Entry fee is \$13.00 as an additional or only class. Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Shetland Sheepdogs eligible for competition in the regular AKC classes, which on the day of the show will be at least seven years of age. Veteran Sweepstakes entries need not be entered in any regular or non-regular classes. Entrants do not need to be titled to compete and sexually altered veterans may compete.

Class winners will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Runner-Up to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes.

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club – PHONE (919) 233-9767 or email juniors@akc.org. For additional information contact American Kennel Club, Junior Showmanship, P.O. Box 900051, Raleigh, NC 27675-9051.

Every field on the entry form related to Junior Showmanship MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who, at the time entries close, have won ten First Places, with competition present, in an Open Class at a licensed or member club. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry without charge, the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: Winners of the classes will compete for Best Junior Handler.

Entry into Junior Showmanship is **FREE**.

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These Obedience Trials are open to Shetland Sheepdogs only.

Qualifying Scores are required for prizes in Regular and Optional Titling classes. Qualifying scores are not required for prizes in the Non-Regular classes. "Dog" means either sex.

JUMP HEIGHTS. Please specify dog's jump height on entry form. Dogs will be separated by jump height in classes with jumps and run in **ASCENDING** order starting at 4". Dogs without jump heights on entry form will be judged at the end of the class.

CLASS TRANSFERS ARE ALLOWED. Transfers (move-ups) must be made by notifying the Event Secretary in writing no later than 30 minutes prior to the trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class is scheduled, the judge is available, and the class has not reached its limit. Exhibitors may submit transfer requests earlier.

REFUND FOR BITCHES IN SEASON. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally classes. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the entry fee for Obedience and/or Rally will be refunded. The exhibitor must provide a veterinarian's certificate within one week of the Trial to obtain the refund. A processing fee of \$10.00 per day will be retained.

* **Brace** - For two Shetland Sheepdogs handled by one handler. They need not be owned by the same person. Dogs may be shown coupled or unattached. Exercises are the same as Novice. 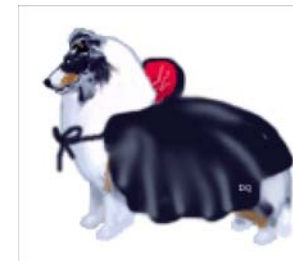

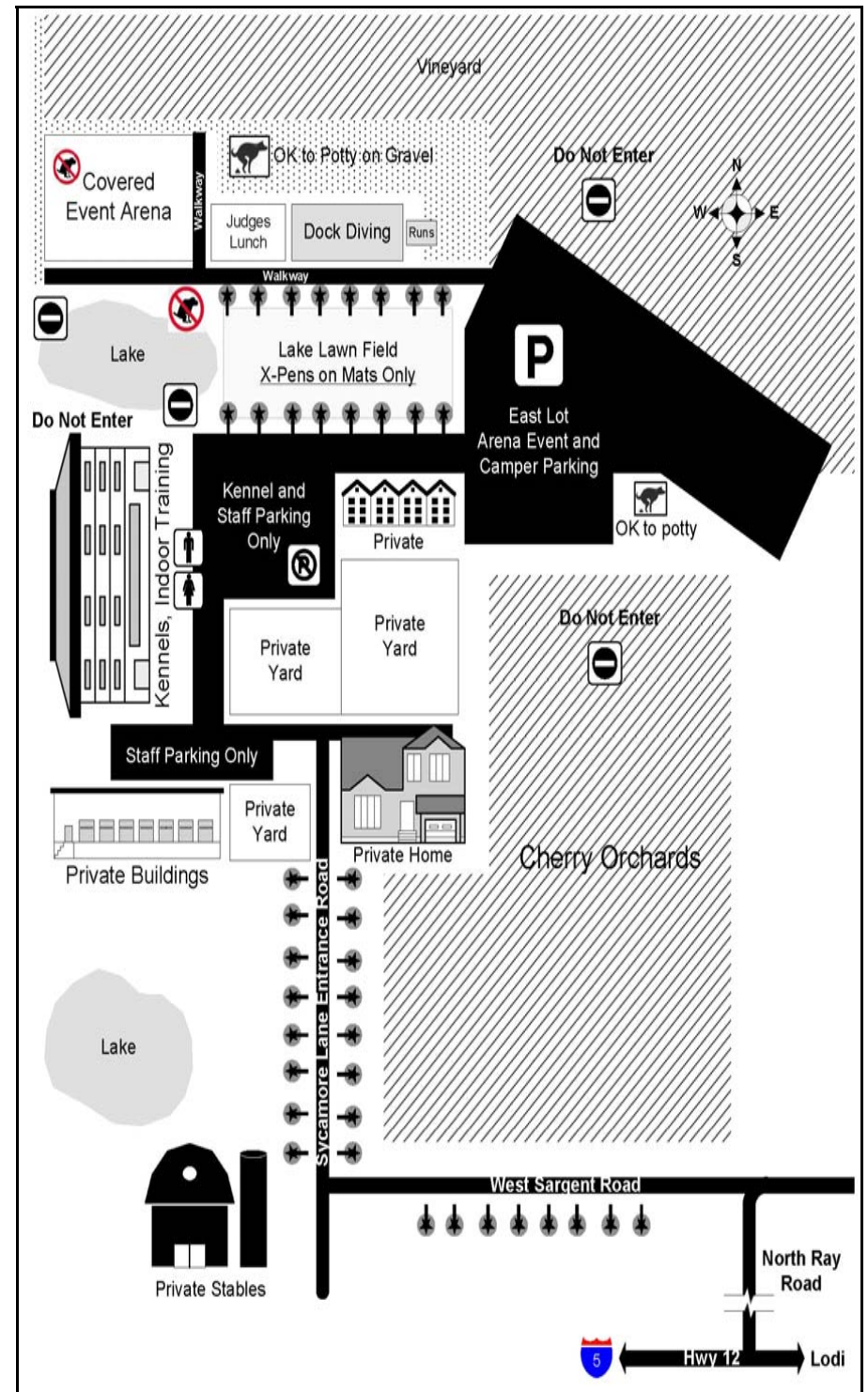
